At the 2013 State of the Union Address, President Obama committed to pledged to take action on climate change, but also stated his intent to push two new free trade agreements (the Trans-Pacific Partnership and the Trans-Atlantic Trade and Investment Agreement. Free Trade Agreement). These objectives are unavoidably in conflict.

Free trade agreements (FTAs):

- grant foreign investors in fossil fuel extraction and biofuel plantation projects the power to sue governments in international tribunals for enforcing environmental laws.
- expand consumption of high carbon footprint animal products and agricultural commodities produced using fossil fuel intensive industrial agriculture.
- prohibit environmental selective purchasing agreements via state procurement rules.
- undermine “buy local” campaigns that reduce fuel use in transportation of goods.
- contribute to deforestation through highway construction for international shipping.

Before sending TPP to Congress, President Obama is expected to first call for Congress to vote on Fast Track Authority, which will force Congress to vote on TPP without changing a single word of the agreement – undermining the role the Constitution sets for Congress in international agreements and preventing Congress from modifying many of the most potentially environmentally destructive aspects of these agreements.

Please vote against Fast Track Authority for these agreements and vote against the agreements themselves when they reach the floor of Congress.
